

Creating an Gmail Filter for MATRIX & ARBOR Emails

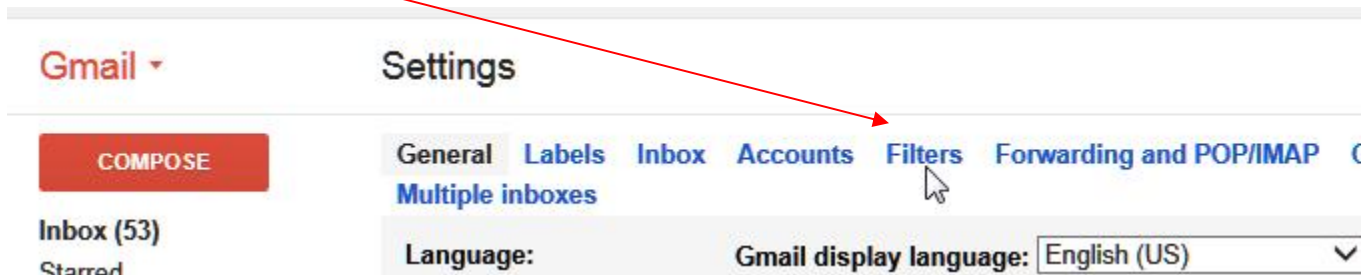
Most email providers allow or block emails from targeted senders or particular subjects. Matrix uses the email address from postmaster@matrixmail.ntreismls.com to actually send the email. ARBOR uses the list host of "Zoom.netatlantic.com".

Setting an "allowed" filter will help your Gmail receive NTREIS and ARBOR emails. This tutorial is for gmail email, but is almost identical in yahoo.com, sbcglobal.net, att.net and many other mail programs.

1. Once logged in to your Gmail program, select "Settings" in the upper right (the symbols that looks like a gear).

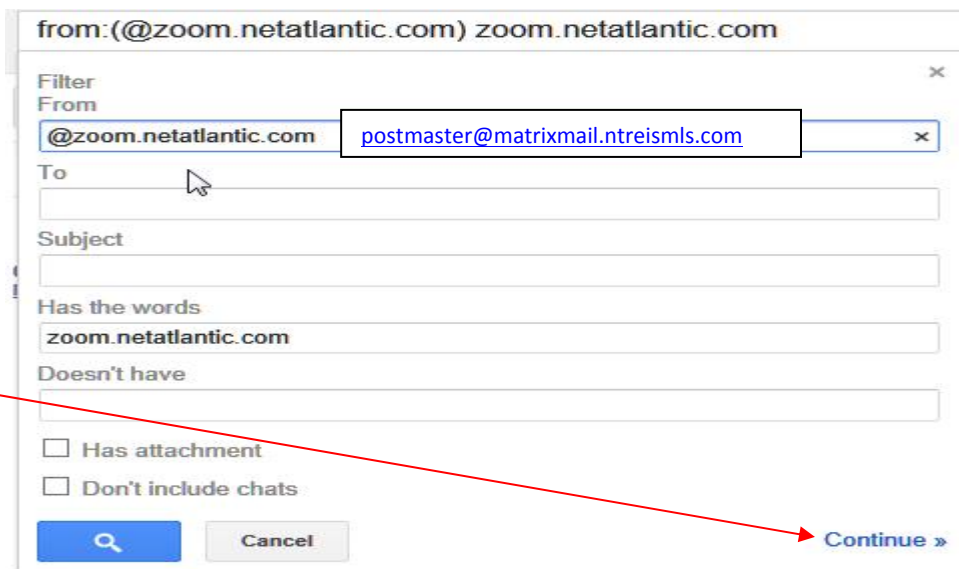


2. Next, select "Filters" from the left menu and then "Add Filter"



3. Next you are going to add an address for ARBOR's or NTREIS email list provider Zoom.netatlantic.com Or postmaster@matrixmail.ntreismls.com

Then Continue



4. Now you'll mark how to treat these emails when they arrive, in this case, anytime a message comes from postmaster@matrixmail.ntreismls.com or zoom.netatlantic.com the filter will move it to the Inbox. Then "Update filter" and you're done!!
